2017 RTC College Scholarship Requirements & Procedures

1. Description

- RTC will award up to four (4) \$2,500 scholarships to 2017 graduating high school seniors for their first year as a (freshman) college student.
- Preference will be given to students going into telecom, IT, electronics, accounting, marketing, or business-related fields who show an interest in returning to RTC's service area after earning their degree.

2. Criteria

You must . . .

- Complete and sign the application
- Be a graduating high school senior entering your freshman year of college in the fall of 2017.
- Be a current member of RTC. To be a member, you or your parents/guardians must have local phone service from RTC.
- Be a United States citizen.
- Have a "C" (2.0) average or better grade 9 thru December of grade 12.
- Be accepted by an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, or vocational-technical school.
- Have been involved in 4 different extra-curricular activities (school, employment, community) during high school. List each activity only once, regardless of the number of years involved.

We will also need . . .

- A transcript from your high school signed by a school official.
- One letter of recommendation from a local community leader other than an educator (examples include telephone company personnel, elected official, local business leader, etc.).

3. Award Procedure:

- Applications will be reviewed and winners selected by a qualified review committee.
- Winners will be notified in May 2017.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- The scholarship check will be mailed to the Financial Aid Office of the institution you will be attending. The check will be made out in the names of the scholarship recipient and the institution. The amount of the scholarship will be divided into two equal disbursements with \$1,250 disbursed in the first semester and \$1,250 in the second semester.
- Scholarship recipient must maintain a "C" (2.0) average or better during their first semester in order to receive the second semester disbursement.
- If a recipient withdraws from school or elects to attend a non-accredited school after receiving a scholarship, the scholarship will be terminated and any refunds from the school will go to RTC.
- If recipient is hired to work at RTC in a full-time capacity after earning their degree, RTC will provide a \$2,500 sign-on bonus.*
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender or disability. Children of current RTC employees or directors are ineligible.

4. When to Apply

- Apply NOW! Applications are available at the RTC offices in Parshall, New Town, and Watford City, www.RTC.coop, and local high schools. Application forms and attachments should be submitted to: RTC, PO Box 68, Parshall ND 58770-0068 and must be postmarked on or before March 1, 2017.
